

All of these men served our country in WWII and have since formed close alliances by meeting every afternoon at Glen's Food Center in Luverne for coffee. They share stories, tell jokes, reminisce, provide support & encouragement and strengthen the 70 some odd years of friendship that they have shared.

In 1945-1946, these brave men returned home from active duty in WW II. They were not greeted with sound of trumpets and the snare of drums. They returned home on the train, bus or by hitch-hiking a ride. After two to four years of a horrible war, they wanted to move on with their lives and they did. They helped to build and create the greatest nation in the world and that is why they are called "THE GREATEST GENERATION."

Today the Band Festival Committee is honored to give them their due...a parade in their honor. THE 62ND TRI-STATE BAND FESITVAL PARADE celebrates their service and sacrifice. We also honor the friendship that they share daily as members. We ask to come together to express of appreciation for this group of WWII veterans representing all WWII veterans who are served this great nation.

In their official membership booklet it states:

"Lest we forget...

This Last Man Club is founded by WWII veterans, members of what has been called the "Greatest Generation." Some may call us heroes, but we are just common men who were called to defend our country and our flag, the symbol of the hopes and dreams of our people. We were willing to sacrifice even our lives to preserve the American way of life – freedom, justice, and opportunity for all – for future generations. We enjoy these freedoms over coffee every afternoon, visiting and sharing

stories and laughter (in English, of course; we're glad we didn't have to learn German or Japanese) and we remember and honor our comrades-in-arms – the special fraternity of America's veterans who served from the opening of hostilities on December 7, 1941 until the final victory on September 2, 1945."

The founding membership is comprised of the WWII veterans who meet daily for coffee at Glen's Deli in Luverne. The Club was formed from individuals in Luverne who were invited to a coffee party at the Governor's Mansion in St. Paul, MN at the invitation of First Lady Mary Pawlenty held on August 8, 2005.
